


Instructions for CIAC Archives

Using CIAC

To post a message to all the list members, send email to ciac@lists.csuchico.edu.

You can subscribe to the list, or change your existing subscription, in the sections below.

Subscribing to CIAC

Subscribe to CIAC by filling out the following form. You will be sent email requesting confirmation, to prevent others from gratuitously subscribing you. Once confirmation is received, your request will be held for approval by the list moderator. You will be notified of the moderator's decision by email. This is also a private list, which means that the list of members is not available to non-members.

You may enter a privacy password below. This provides only mild security, but should prevent others from messing with your subscription. **Do not use a valuable password** as it will occasionally be emailed back to you in cleartext.





Good afternoon, Jeanne. Happy New Year.

College of the Desert includes all courses completed when calculating GPA for graduation purposes. Other institutions' degree applicable and non degree applicable courses are also included in graduation calculation and in Honors calculation; even those courses not accepted by COD. The credit/no credit issue is moot because CR/NC credit is not calculated into GPA; only letter grades A-F.

We also ask that students provide transcripts from all other institutions attended but have no procedure in place to guarantee they do so; there is other institutions information available within the CCC Apply application, however some students simply neglect to offer that information in their application packet. There have been a few incidents in which I've requested a student provide transcripts because I'm aware they attended another institution; when this occurs I inform them that I cannot award honors without transcripts. But these occasions are few and there is no procedure in place to verify other institution attendance.
